

The West Houston Association strongly supports for federal funding the proposed priority rebuilding of Memorial Drive from Kirkwood to Eldridge proposed by the City of Houston.

- This project will greatly enhance this critical mobility project to improve traffic flow to and from major activity centers, enhance access to adjoining properties and improving traffic and pedestrian safety for neighborhoods.
- It is a long needed improvement as the adjacent residential and commercial community have completely outgrown the original rural design of the facility. Memorial, as a major arterial feed to the Energy Corridor, serves as only one of two east-west major thoroughfares between Interstate 10 and Westheimer and as such completely fails during morning and afternoon peak hour traffic.
